N.B. : ABILITY TO READ, WRITE AND SPEAK IN BENGALI IS AN ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST AND SERVICE MENTIONED BELOW PROVIDED THAT THE SAID COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT OF KNOWLEDGE IN BENGALI IS NOT APPLICABLE FOR THOSE CANDIDATES WHOSE MOTHER TONGUE IS NEPALI. THIS WILL BE TESTED AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW.

QUALIFICATIONS :

- (i) Must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) Must be a 'Graduate in Science' of any recognized University of India having with 'Basic Knowledge in Computer'.

MINIMUM PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT:

- (a) Before appointment the selected candidates shall be medically examined by the competent Medical Officer with regard to their fitness for the appointment to the post. In addition the candidates must have the following minimum visual standard viz.

- (b) Persons with disabilities will be allowed concession as per provision contained in Notification No. 746-SW, dated 28.02.2011 of Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare.

AGE: The candidate must have attained the age of 21 years but not more than 36 years on 01.01.2018.

METHOD OF RECRUITMENT: Selection by written test and interview through the Commission.

SYLLABUS FOR WRITTEN EXAMINATION

There would be only one paper for 2:30 hours duration which will be divided in the following subject. The written test will be of objective type and comprise of 200 marks. The marks for each subject is indicated against each.

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Interview: Total Marks: 100

In personality test each candidate may be asked questions on (i) his/her subject (ii) general ideas on Finger Prints (iii) Basic computer Knowledge and (iv) any other topic as deem fit by Board members.

Note:- The object of the test will be to assess the candidate's personal qualities e.g. alertness of mind, power of clear and logical exposition, intellectual and moral integrity, leadership.

PROBATION:

The selected candidate shall be on probation for 03 (three) years. The appointing authority may extend a probationers prescribed period of probation by such period not exceeding one year as the appointing authority deems appropriate. A probationer shall have to undergo the following schedule of training during the probationary period.

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| (a) | Training | 12 months in the FPB, CID, WB. |
| (b) | Working under an expert | 12 months in the FPB, CID, WB. |
| (c) | Independent work | 12 months in the third and last year
the candidate shall have to under go the
independent work along with practical
training in the FPB, CID, WB. |

After completion of 3(three) years of satisfactory service in FPB, CID, WB, every candidate shall have to pass the All India Board Examination of Finger Print Expert conducted by the CFPB, Government of India, New Delhi, so as to be declared as a Finger Print Expert.

CONFIRMATION:

- A candidate will be confirmed only after passing the All India Board Examination for Finger Print Expert conducted by CFPB, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- A candidate is entitled to restore increments that fall due during the prescribed period of probation after passing the All India Board Examination of Finger Print Expert conducted by CFPB, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- A candidate is not entitled to restore any increment after the expiry of period of probation unless and until the candidate is confirmed.
- There shall be no limit of number of attempts for appearing the All India Board Examination conducted by CFPB, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

Fee: Rs. 160/- (Rupees one hundred sixty) only. In addition to that, the candidates will be charged as follows:

(i) For online payment through debit/credit cards: Convenience fee 1% of the examination fee subject to a minimum of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five) only plus 18% G.S.T. on convenience fee.

(ii) For online payment through net banking: Convenience fee of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five) only plus 18% G.S.T. on convenience fee.

(iii) For offline payment through bank counter: Service Charge of Rs. 20/- (Rupees Twenty) only.

S.C./S.T. candidates of West Bengal and Persons with disabilities (P.W.D.) having physical disability of 40% and above are not required to pay any fee. BC candidates of West Bengal are, however, required to pay usual fee as aforesaid. NO EXEMPTION OF FEE IS AVAILABLE TO S.C./S.T. CANDIDATES OF OTHER STATES AND B.C. CANDIDATES. No claim for refund of the fee will be entertained nor will it be held in reserve for any other examination.

INFORMATION

- SUBMISSION OF MORE THAN ONE APPLICATION FOR ONE PARTICULAR POST IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. THE CANDIDATURE OF A CANDIDATE WHO SUBMITS MORE THAN ONE APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE SELECTION PROCEDURE, WILL BE CANCELLED EVEN IF HE/SHE IS ADMITTED TO THE SAME.
- The qualifications prescribed in the advertisement are as per the notified recruitment rules issued by Government.
- All the degrees/diplomas/certificates mentioned in the advertisement must have been obtained from recognized Universities/Institutions.
- IN THE CASE OF WRITTEN TEST, CANDIDATES SUFFERING FROM BLINDNESS OR LOW VISION WILL BE ALLOWED THE HELP OF A SCRIBE, IF REQUIRED. THE SCRIBE SHOULD NOT POSSESS EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION HIGHER THAN THE REQUISITE QUALIFICATION FOR THE POST.
- Besides pay, the posts carry allowances as admissible.

6. The benefits of reservation of vacancies and upper age concession upto 5 years are admissible only to S.C. and S.T. candidates of West Bengal and upto 3 years to O.B.C. (category 'A' & 'B') candidates of West Bengal. S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates of other States may apply for unreserved vacancies as general candidates. Such benefits are also available upto the age of 45 years for Persons with disabilities
(a) A candidate claiming to be S.C., S.T., B.C. or persons with disabilities (40% and above) must have a certificate in support of his/her claim from a competent authority of West Bengal as specified below:
For S.C., S.T. and B.C. candidates:
(i) In the district, the Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub-Division concerned, and
(ii) In Kolkata, the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas or such Additional District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, as may be authorized by the District Magistrate, South 24-Parganas, on behalf and the District Welfare Officer, Kolkata and Ex-officio Joint Director, Backward Classes Welfare.

For Persons with Disabilities:

- (b) The Public Service Commission may require such further proof of particulars from the candidates as it may consider necessary and may make enquiries about their character and other particulars regarding suitability and eligibility.
(c) S.C., S.T., O.B.C. OR PERSON WITH DISABILITY CERTIFICATE MUST BE OBTAINED WITHIN THE CLOSING DATE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS AND NO CLAIM IN THIS REGARD WILL BE ENTERTAINED AFTERWARDS.
